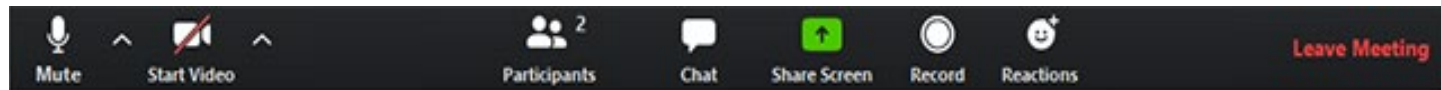

FIGURE 4: NONPROFIT SOURCES OF REVENUE, 2022



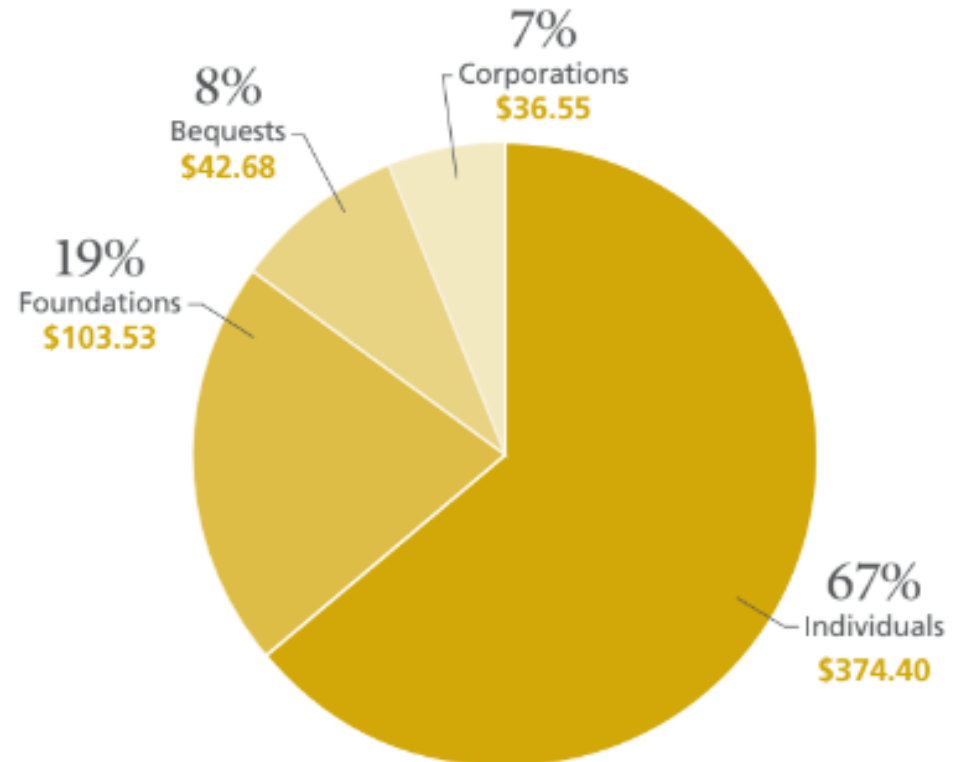

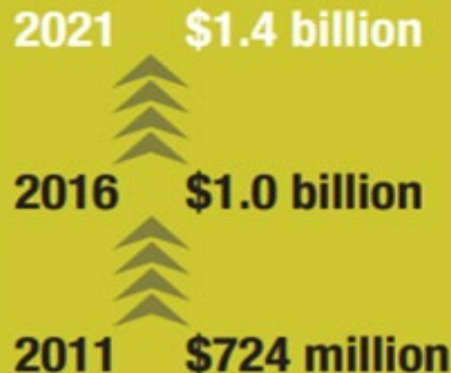

- Assets come from a business



Community

- Assets from multiple sources
- Support a specific community



Private

- Commonly one source of income



Operating

- Purposive, most do not issue grants

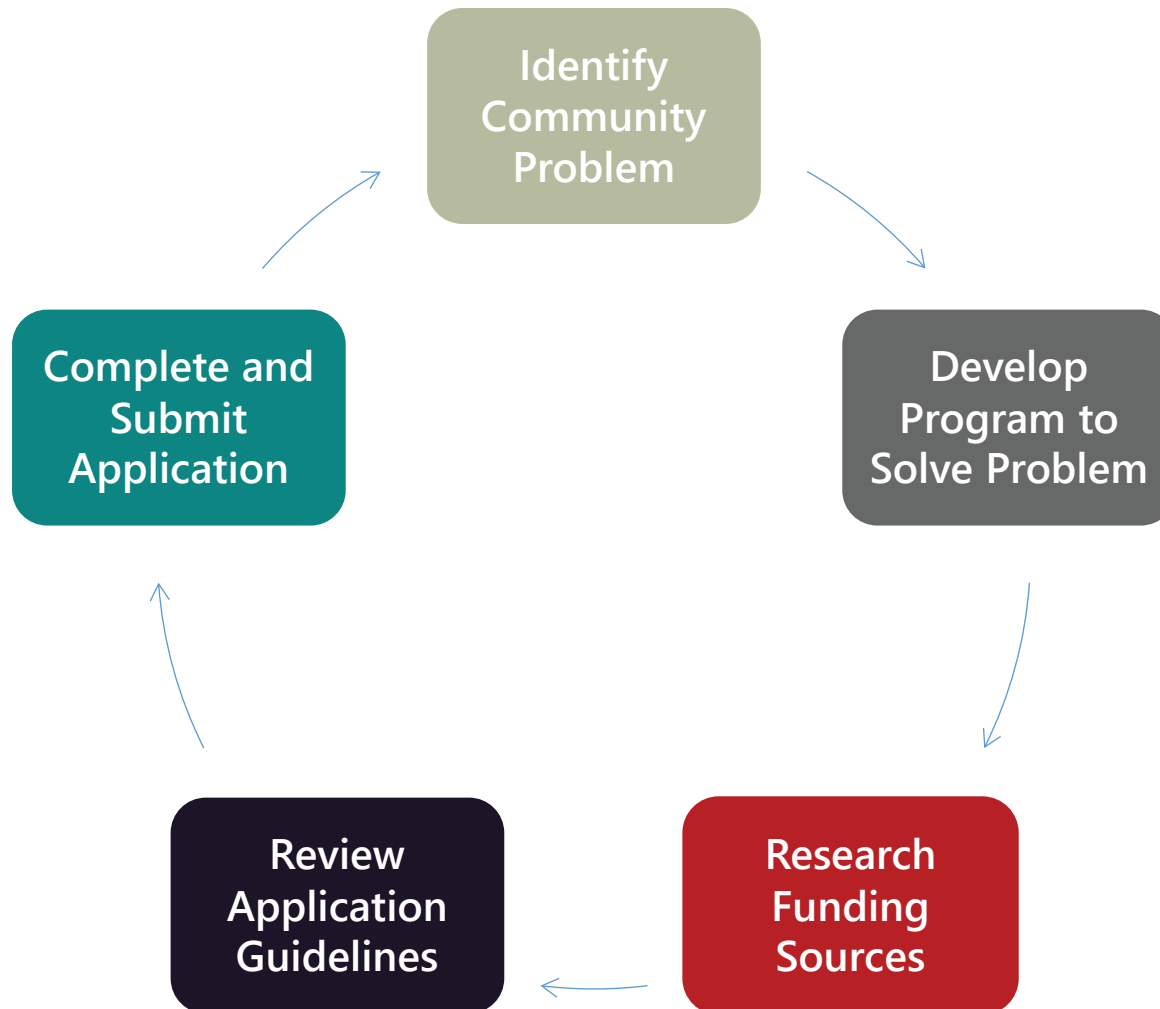


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Grant Seeking Process

YOUR POST-RESEARCH PLAN

Grant Management Plan

- Prioritize potential funders
- Create a work plan
- Identify who should be involved/responsible?
 - Leadership / Program / Financial staff
- Fund development calendar
 - Can you meet the deadlines?
 - What information is needed?
 - Fund development calendar
- Gather and track all grant information

Grant Management Plan

- Review previous grant applications
- Annual report and newsletters
- Collect Internal information
 - 501c3/tax-exempt status letter
 - Financial information
 - Evaluation information
 - Planning documents (strategic, business, program)
- External research to build your case

Contact the Funders

- Technical assistance?
- Proposal review?
- How are decisions made?
- Attachments?
- Budget requirements?
- What cycle to apply?
- Multi-year grant options?
- When can I re-apply?



Contacts you make may prove invaluable, even if not for now.

- Consistent

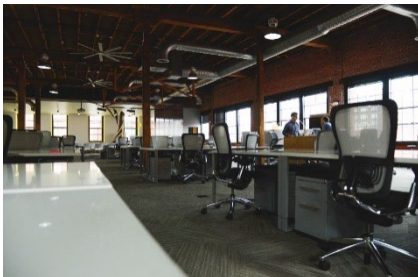
