Copper Mountain Lodging Check-In

The Copper Lodging Front Desk is located at 509 Copper Rd, Copper Mtn, Co 80443. When you turn into Copper, go past the first stop sign and we are the 3rd building on the right, past the [Woodward at Copper](#) Barn. Look for the rock sign that says Lodging Check-in and Athletic Club.

If you arrive before 4pm, pre checking-in confirms your reservation and we'll give you your room keys, your check-in packet and a map with directions where you're staying. We'll take your cell phone number and either send you a text or call you when your room is ready.

If you arrive after sundown look for the blue tree above the Lodging Check-in sign (the entrance is before the sign, but if you pass it there's another entrance to the right just ahead).

Rural Philanthropy Days Registration and Check-In

Directions from Copper to Breckenridge Riverwalk Center:

Get on I-70 E. Head northeast on Copper Rd toward CO-91 S. Turn left onto CO-91 N. Use any lane to turn right to merge onto I-70 E toward Denver. Follow I-70 E and CO-9 S to W Washington Ave in Breckenridge. Merge onto I-70 E. Take exit 203 for CO-9 S toward Frisco. Turn right onto CO-9 S/Summit Blvd (signs for Frisco). Continue to follow CO-9 S. At the traffic circle, take the 2nd exit and stay on CO-9 S. Slight right onto CO-9. Drive to W Adams Ave. Turn left onto W Washington Ave. Turn right onto W Adams Ave. Destination will be on the left.

Directions from Copper to Silverthorne Pavilion:

Head northeast on Copper Rd toward CO-91 S. Turn left onto CO-91 N. Use any lane to turn right to merge onto I-70 E toward Denver. Use the right 2 lanes to take exit 205 for US-6 E/CO-9 N toward Silverthorne/Dillon. Use the left 2 lanes to turn sharply left onto CO-9 N/US-6 W/Blue River Pkwy (signs for Silverthorne). Continue to follow.
